Old envelopes, paper, and newspapers are recycled. John is not putting the magazines in the bin. He is collecting them for his dentist.

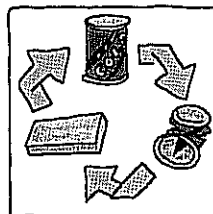
Mike's teacher is putting toys and clothes into cardboard boxes. She gives them to the hospital. She uses very old clothes as rags for painting.

**Jill** No, you can take this bottle back to the shop. They wash it and use it again. That's the best kind of recycling.



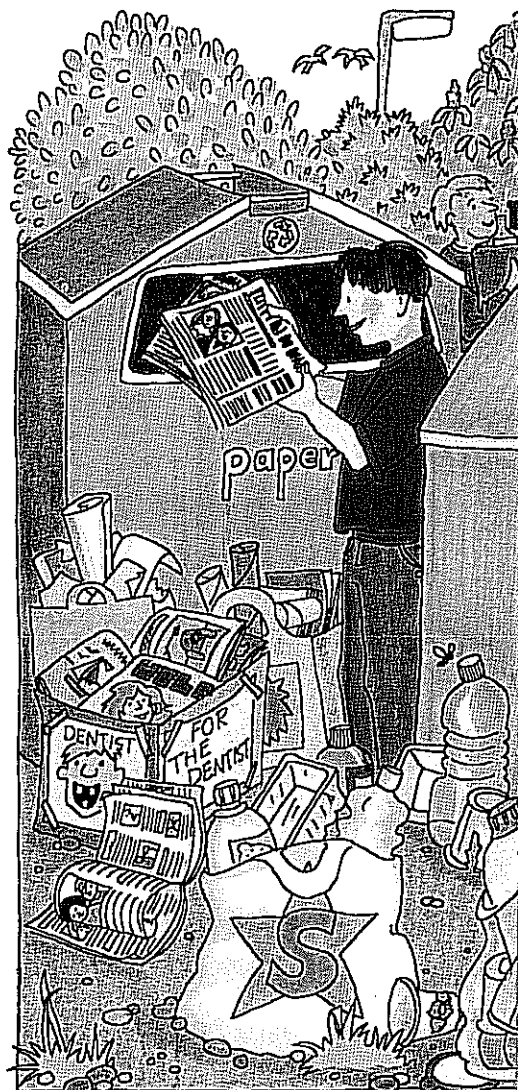

**Mum** There's 'Cartoon Time'. That looks good.

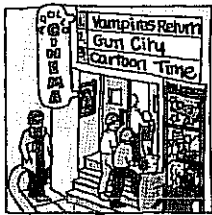
**Mike** That's Saturday morning only.

**Jill** They're a good band. That's Johnny in the picture. He plays electric guitar.



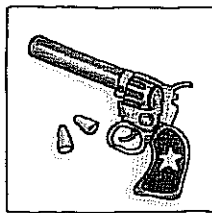
